## TRUSTING THE GRACE OF GOD

A grandmother pushes her grandson out of the path of a speeding car, and is hit by the car and dies. A stranger jumps into a surging river to save a young girl, and loses his own life. A firefighter is killed battling a blaze to rescue three trapped people. Recently, in Ellicott, Maryland, a military veteran jumps into raging flood waters to help a young woman find you beloved pet and he drowns. Their concern for others leads these real-life heroes to make the ultimate sacrifice.

Like the grandson, the young girl, the three trapped people, and the woman who can't find her pet, we too have been saved from death at a great cost – Jesus' loving sacrifice in obedience to God's will. Paul reminds us that our justification – our reconciliation and peace with God – not a reward we deserve for being good. It is God's free gift of love and salvation despite our weakness and sin. And that is grace. Put your faith not in your own ability to please God, but in God's abundant grace.
