HOLY TRINITY ANNUAL PARISH FESTIVAL

Our Sister Church, Holy Trinity Ukrainian Catholic Church in Carnegie, PA, is holding their annual parish festival on their church grounds. The festival dates are August 25 from 12 PM to 8 PM and August 26 from 12 PM till 8 PM. They will have live music, Ukrainian food and games.

We will put a sign-up sheet on the table in the vestibule. Anyone wishing to go can put their name and day they wish to go and we will see about making transportation arrangements.

THE TRANSFIGURATION

The Gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke each contain story in Matthew 17:1-13, called the Transfiguration. Jesus goes up a mountain with his select disciples, who get to see him in his full glory, as brilliant as the sun. In the Old Testament, mountains are sacred places where people encounter God. The same is true here, God's voice comes from a cloud overshadowing the mountain, and God reveals to the disciples that Jesus is God's beloved Son. Moses representing the Law, and Elijah representing the prophets, also appear with Jesus. The appearance of these two Old Testament heroes confirms that Jesus is the fulfillment of both the Law and the prophets – a key point for the author of Matthew.
