His Excellency Most Reverend John Bura, Auxiliary Bishop-Emeritus of the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Philadelphia was called to the Lord on January 17th at 3:30 PM after an extended hospital stay having received the Sacraments.

Funeral services will be celebrated on January 23-24, 2023 at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Philadelphia with Metropolitan Borys Gudziak as principal celebrant.

Bishop Bura's body will lie in state for viewing and prayer starting at 2 p.m. on Monday, January 23rd at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception. The Episcopal Parastas will be held the same day at 4:30 p.m.

A funeral Divine Liturgy will be celebrated on Tuesday, January 24 at 9:30 a.m. After the Liturgy, the remains of Bishop Bura will be transferred to St. Andrew Cemetery in Bound Brook, NJ for interment.

The services will be open to the public and all clergy religious and faithful are encouraged to spiritually accompany Bishop John on his last journey.
