REFLECTIONS FOR THE LENTEN SEASON

The Eucharist presumes relationships. Relationships are built upon covenants. , connections that we have with each other. In Christ, we are bound to each other. We show this in the Liturgy.

REFLECTION

What makes the Liturgy different from a crowd at a sporting event or a movie theater is the powerful way Catholics are already connected to other Catholics even before Liturgy begins. This is reinforced even more strongly by the Liturgy itself. When we come to Liturgy, it is as members of the same Body of Christ, united by the Holy Spirit that was given to us in our Baptism. During the Liturgy, our sense of connection increases by the common responses we make as a community together. We are brothers and sisters. Even more dramatically, we all receive the same Communion, uniting us with Jesus – and with each other – in the most powerful way.

QUESTION

How anonymous is your experience of other people at Liturgy? How might you grow in your connections with other believers?

PRAYER

Lord, you are indeed with us, in our spirit, in the bonds that make up our community of faith. Let our worship together in the Liturgy bring us into greater unity of mind and heart. I pray this in the name of Jesus and his Spirit. Amen.
