A SPIRITUAL PILGRIMAGE

Over the next few weeks we will be taking a spiritual pilgrimage. A pilgrimage is intended as a sacred journey with a specific intention. Our journey will be an inner journey, and our specific intention is Eucharistic Consecration. This spiritual pilgrimage you can make in the comfort of your favorite chair. It will be the longest journey you ever make without moving an inch. Readings, prayers, and other resources are arranged day-by-day and under a weekly theme. The reflections are designed to be deeply spiritual and intensely practical.

Here is a step-by-step guide for your spiritual pilgrimage:

1. Find a quiet place.
2. Read the reflection.
3. Ponder the one idea that struck you most from the reading for a few moments.
4. Pray the Spiritual Communion.
5. Look for opportunities to adopt the virtue of the day amidst your daily activities.

“This is the day the Lord has made, let us rejoice and be glad.” Psalm 118:24

Reflect on these 5 questions: 1) Who am I? 2) Where did I come from? 3) What am I here for? 4) How do I do it? 5) Where am I going?

LESSON: Life is a pilgrimage. We are just passing through this world.

VIRTUE OF THE DAY: Patience: The virtue of patience deepens your ability to meet life’s challenges. It is a form of suffering. Though often mild, it does refine character and soul. You can discipline yourself to be patient. This is what the and happy do.

SPIRITUAL COMMUNION: Jesue, I believe that You are truly present in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Eucharist. Every day I long for more of You. I love You above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot receive You sacramentally at this moment, I invite You to com and dwell in my heart. May this spiritual communion increase my desire for the Eucharist. You are the healer of my soul. Thake the blindness from my eyes, the deafness from my ears, and the hardness from my heart. Fill me with the grace, wisdom, and courage to do Your will in all things. My Lord and my God, draw me close to You, nearer than ever before. Amen.
