A SPIRITUAL PILGRIMAGE

Without the purposeful determination of a pilgrim, we are destined to live life of distraction. Today, most men and women lead lives of distraction. Lack of focus leads to lack of commitment, and together these lead us to lives of quiet (and not so quiet) desolation. Consecration changes all that. It challenges us to name what matters most. It gives us the clarity and wisdom to focus on the vital few rather than chasing the trivial many. It encourages us to place Jesus at the center of our days and weeks. And it liberates us from all the distractions and superficiality that dominates the culture.

LESSON

One of the biggest traps a pilgrim can fall into is the trap of FOMO (Fear Of Missing Out). Driven by the psychological nonsense of FOMO, many people make the worst decisions of their lives. The only things that matter are those that God has chosen for you. It is preferable to miss out on everything else. Doing the will of God transforms FOMO into JOMO (Joy Of Missing Out).

VIRTUE OF THE DAY

Discipline: The virtue of discipline allows us to maximize our contributions to the world. Joy is a byproduct of realizing our God-given potential. You will never have more joy than discipline. By choosing to discipline ourselves, we suffer less and cause less suffering for others.

SPIRITUAL COMMUNION
