THE PILGRIM'S VIRTUE

By the second Friday of January most New Year's resolutions have been abandoned. On this pilgrim journey together, we are encouraged to persevere. Perseverance is the pilgrim's virtue. Many people will abandon this path of consecration. Decide that you will not be one of them. Just keep showing up. Show up each day regardless of how you feel or if it is convenient. Just show up and let God work on you. Never forget that each time you receive Jesus in the Eucharist He is working in you, to send you out into the world so that He can work through you. **TRUST, SURRENDER, BELIEVE, RECEIVE.**

LESSON

Just keep showing up for prayer and your other spiritual practices. Show up each day regardless of how you feel, or if it is convenient, or whether or not you think it is bearing any fruit. God's ways are mysterious. He is at work in your soul like the roots of a mighty tree beneath the surface. Just because you don't know what God is doing doesn't mean He isn't preparing you for whatever is next. Just show up and let Him work on you.

VIRTUE OF THE DAY

Perseverance: The virtue of perseverance is essential for friendship and love. Perseverance teaches us to resolve difficulties. Acquiring this virtue requires both grace and significant personal effort. There is no virtue in beginning. It is easy. Many start, few finish. This is true in almost everything. Don't look at how far you still have to go, look at how far you have come, and consider how your life would be if you had never found this path at all.
