**A SPIRITUAL PILGRIMAGE**

**THERESE OF LISIEUX: JESUS IN EVERY TABERNACLE**

Saint Therese of Lisieux was a nun who lived in a Carmelite convent in southern France. Therese believed that love is expressed through attention to the small things that fill our daily lives. We can all practice “The Little Way” which was taught by Therese. Every Holy Moment is a historic event. Every time we choose to love God, and collaborate with Him to love our neighbor, we change the course of human history, because our Holy Moments reverberate powerfully in the lives of people in other places and other times.

Therese of Lisieux entered the convent at the age of fifteen and died at the age of twenty-four, but her influence continues to resonate in the lives of more than 4,500 Missionaries of Charity (the order Mother Theresa founded) who worked in 133 countries today. It is impossible to measure Saint Therese of Lisieux's impact on history, but it is vast. Holiness is deeply personal, but it is also communal and historic. Holiness is not something we do for ourselves, it is something God does in us when we cooperate. It is something He does in us, not for us alone, but for others and for all of history.

Therese of Lisieux was a great teacher for all, and she will generously share her wisdom with us if we open ourselves to "The Little Way".

We live in a world that worships complexity and grandiosity, but the genius of God is found in the simplicity of ordinary things. The Eucharist is the ultimate expression of His ordinary way, coming to us in the simplicity of bread and wine.

## **LESSON**

There is no love without sacrifice. Love is indispensable for a Christian, and therefore, so is sacrifice. Make small sacrifices each day that clearly demonstrate you love for God and neighbor.

## **VIRTUE OF THE DAY**

Sacrifice: The virtue of sacrifice enhances the meaning of our existence. The ability to set aside our desires and personal preferences, expecting nothing in return, is evidence of the human person. Let your selfishness give way to love and you will embrace the sacrifices of daily life enthusiastically.

## **SPIRITUAL COMMUNION**

Jesus, I believe that You are truly present in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Eucharist. Every day I long for more of You. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot receive You sacramentally at this moment, I invite You to come and dwell in my heart. May this spiritual communion increase my desire for the Eucharist. You are the healer of my soul. The blindness from my eyes, the deafness from my ears, the darkness from my mind, and the hardness from my heart. Fill me with the grace, wisdom, and courage to do Your will in all things. My Lord and my God, draw me close to You, nearer than ever before. AMEN.
